




We recommend that once you've selected the best format for your media that you arrange a time with the office to come and test your media to ensure that your media will work on the day of your service.



HOW TO DISPLAY: PICTURES



Pictures can be displayed on the television by the following methods:

USB

- to display pictures/images it is best to arrange photos on the USB in a folder Name folder so it is easy to find. E.g. Photos for service
- the USB is inserted and supported by the blu-ray player and is visible on the television screen
- supported picture formats: .JPG, JPEG, GIF, & PNG

DVD

- slideshows and pictures can be burned to a dvd/blu-ray
- the dvd/blu-ray is inserted into the blu-ray player and is visible on the television screen
- supported dvd formats: Blu-ray, dvd rom, dvd R, dvd RW, CD-R/RW

LAPTOP COMPUTER

- can be hooked up to the television using a HDMI cable (provided)
- be sure to bring the computers power cord
- display media as you would on your computer screen (note: no access to internet)

HOW TO PLAY:

MUSIC



Music can played through the sound system by the following methods:

USB

- to play audio files/playlists it is best to arrange on the USB in a folder Name folder so it is easy to find. E.g. Music for service
- the USB is inserted and supported by the blu-ray player and songs are visible on the television screen
- supported music formats: .wma, .mp3 and m4a (DRM free)

IPOD, MP3, TABLET, CELL PHONE

- hooked up to the sound system by using AUX input/output cable (provided)
- inserted into the device and into the wall port to play music directly off the device

LAPTOP COMPUTER

- can be hooked up to the television using a HDMI cable (provided)
- be sure to bring the computers power cord
- play music/playlists as you would on your computer screen (note: no access to internet)
- May need to adjust settings on laptop for audio to go through chapel speakers

HOW TO PLAY:

VIDEO



Videos can play through the television and sound system by the following methods:

USB

- to play video files it is best to arrange on the USB in a folder. Name folder so it is easy to find. E.g. Video for service
- the USB is inserted and supported by the blu-ray player and is visible on the television screen (provided)
- supported video formats: .avi, .mpg, .mpeg, .mp4, .wmv, .m4v (DRM free), .mov

CELL PHONE (with micro HDMI port)

- hooked up to the sound system by using AUX input/output cable (provided), insert into the device and into the wall port to play music directly off the device

LAPTOP COMPUTER

- can be hooked up to the television using a HDMI cable (provided)
- be sure to bring the computers power cord
- play videos as you would on your computer screen (note: no access to internet)
- May need to adjust settings on laptop for audio to go through chapel speakers
