








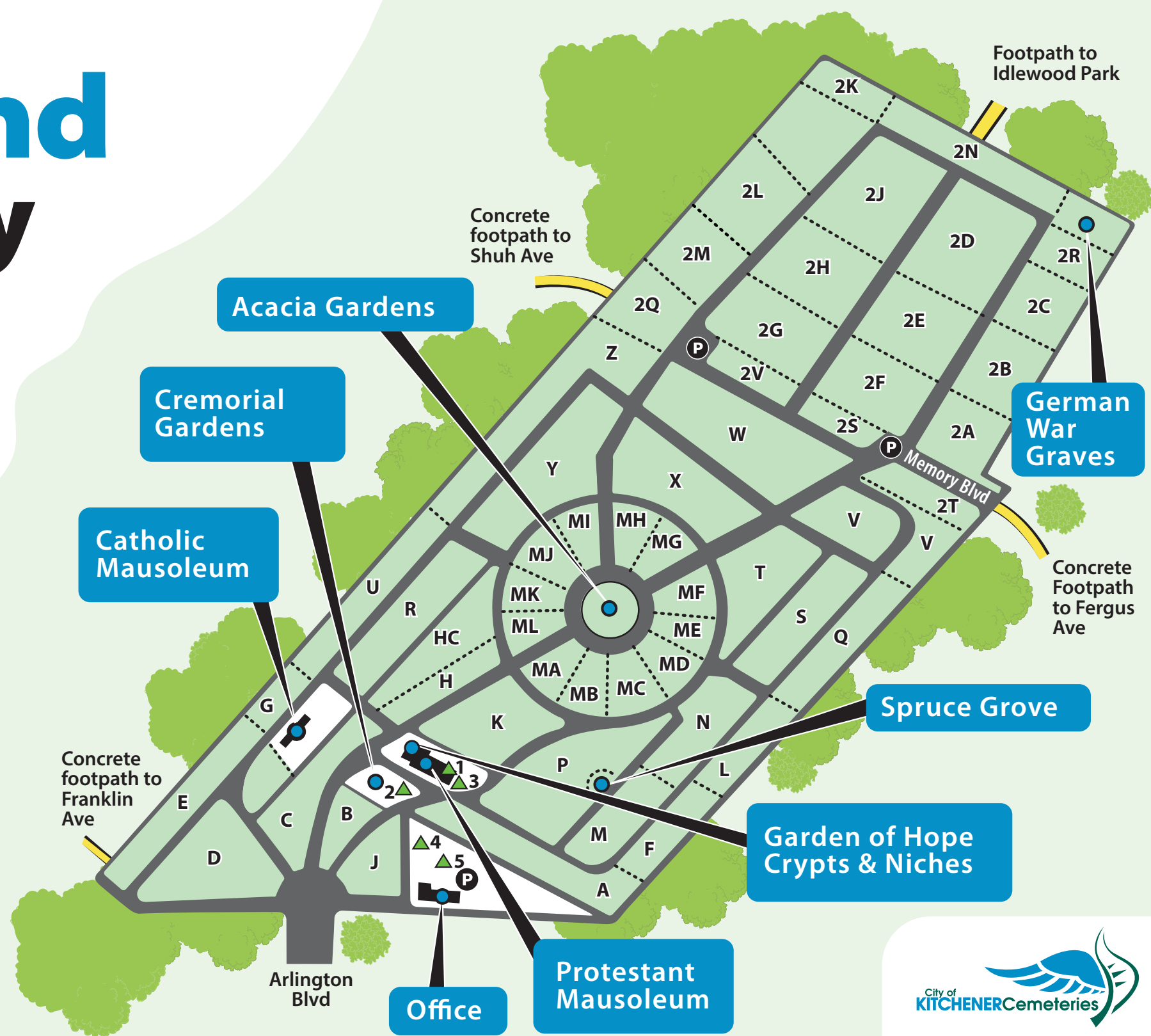

Woodland Cemetery

Visual description:

Footpath (yellow), Vehicle Path (dark grey), Plot Sections (light green), Area Dividers (dashed lines), Buildings (black squares), Landmarks (blue circles), Columbarium (green triangles), Tree Area (bright green tree icon) and Parking Lot (black circle with letter P inside circle).

Woodland Cemetery is a long horizontal rectangle shape that is slightly tilted down to the left to be on an angle and is divided up into many sections which is described below:

Top right of map - Footpath to Idlewood Park leading to cemetery lot sections #2A-2V. The Landmark near Idlewood Park path is the German War Graves.

Middle left of map - Concrete footpath to Shuh Avenue leading to the same #2A-2V plot cemetery sections as per above and a parking area.

Middle right side of map - Concrete Footpath to Fergus Avenue leading into Memory Boulevard and to #2A-2V cemetery sections on the right and on the left other cemetery sections A-Z and another parking area.

Bottom left side of map at bottom - Concrete footpath to Franklin Avenue leading to plot sections A-Z starting from bottom and moving up towards Shuh Avenue path again.

Catholic Mausoleum landmark is near this footpath. Farther Southeast of this Mausoleum are Cremorial Gardens Landmark, Garden of Hope Crypts and Niches, Spruce Grove Landmark, and the Protestant Mausoleum.

In the centre of map is the Acacia Gardens Landmark. It is surrounded by cemetery sections MA-ML in a circular fashion.

At the bottom of the map is the entrance on Arlington Boulevard and the office is located to your right.

Kitchener Cemeteries logo appears in the bottom right-hand corner.
