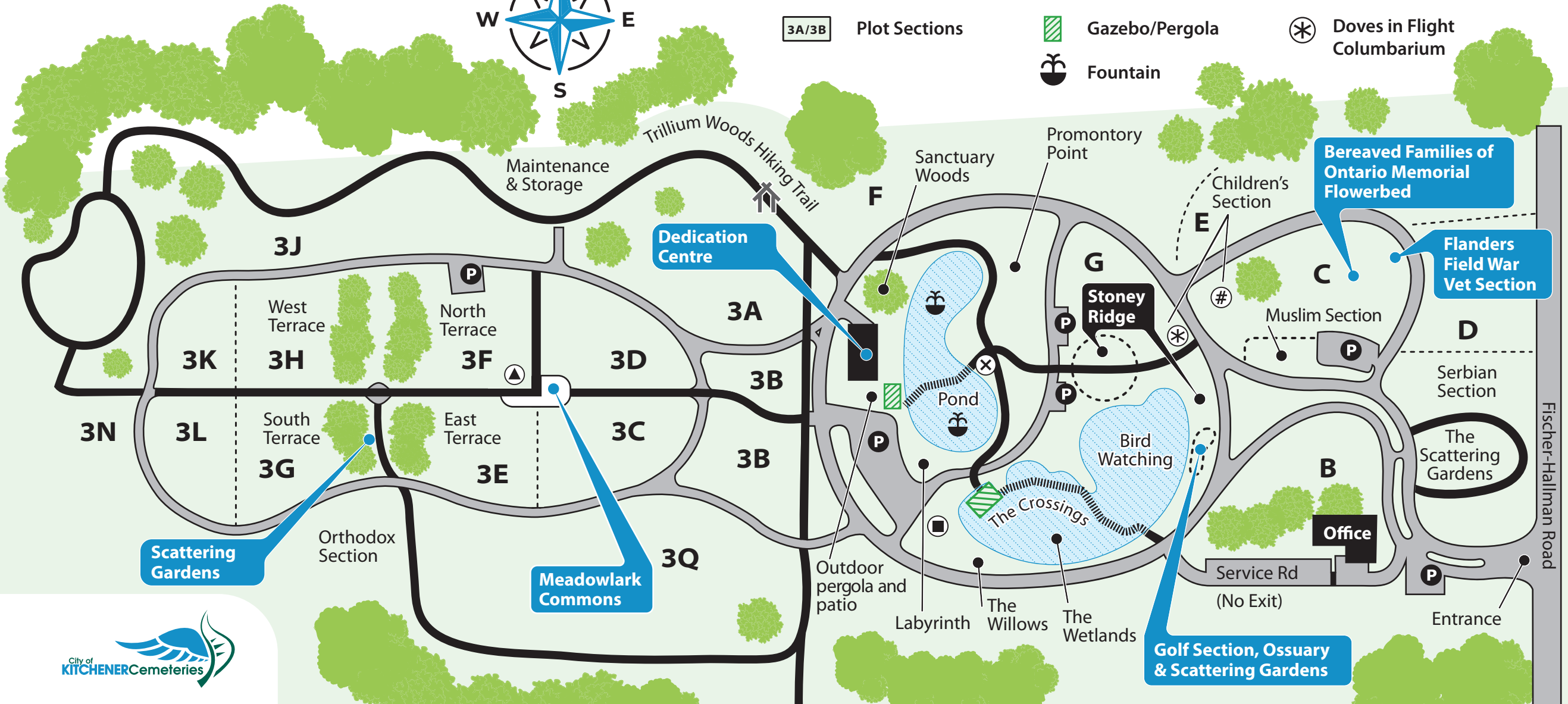

Williamsburg Cemetery is a long horizontal rectangle shape that is divided up into many sections which is described below:

Starting from the right side of the map (this is where the main entrance is located) you enter the Cemetery from Fischer-Hallman Road. The main office and parking are located to your immediate left as well as a service road for staff. On your right you will see The Scattering Gardens, Serbian Section and across the road the Muslim Section. This road will then split into 2 and you can follow either road all through the picturesque cemetery.

Plot Sections start with B, C, D, E and in these sections, you will find landmarks for Bereaved Families of Ontario Memorial Flowerbed and Flanders Field War Vet Section. The Children's section is also beside the Bereaved families landmark in section C.

If you continue to the right of the cemetery road you will pass section E and F. On your left you will see the focal point of the cemetery that has a large pond with 2 fountains and another water feature with a gazebo and walking bridge area called The Crossings and Bird Watching that leads to landmark called Golf Section, Ossuary & Scattering Gardens. In the central area you will also find Sanctuary Woods and Promontory Point. On the left of the centre area towards the The Crossings you will find The Wetlands, The Willows, Labyrinth and the Outdoor Pergola and Patio. At the very back of this area you will encounter the Dedication Centre. If you continue you will see cemetery sections 3A, 3B, 3C, 3D, 3E, 3F, 3G, 3H, 3J, 3K, 3L and 3N.

From this spot the road splits off again in three directions. To your right you can follow tree lined Trillium Woods Hiking Trail. Along this trail you will find the Maintenance & Storage area, continue on the trail until you reach the back of the last cemetery sections.

Hopping back on the road at the back of the Cemetery you will pass the cemetery sections mentioned above and also see Landmarks The Scattering Gardens, Meadowlark Commons and Orthodox Section. In the centre of these back cemetery sections it's divided into West, North, South and East Terraces.

You can follow the Hiking Trail and roads throughout Williamsburg Cemetery.
